#### **FUND 101 - GENERAL FUND**

#### Revenues

- Decrease Public Safety Grants by \$17,637 to reflect EBP Grant Budget Revision.
   Expenditure lines are being reduced by the same amount
- Increase Community Development Grants by \$57,341 to reflect the unused portion of the CDBG Food Insecurity Grant from FY 2024-2025. Expenditure lines are being increased and adjusted to net the same amount.
- Decrease Other Federal Through State by \$42,010 to remove Drug Endangered Children (DEC) Grant from Budget. Funding ended in FY 2024-2025 and was temporarily replaced by the State Opioid Response VI (SOR4) Grant, which was included in the approved FY 2025-2026 budget. DEC funding is expected to return in the Fall of 2025. Expenditure lines are being reduced by the same amount.
- Increase Other Direct Federal Revenue by \$46,330 to reflect the unused portion of the SAMHSA grant received by the Ambulance Service in FY 2024-2025. Funds must be expended by 9/30/25. Expenditure lines are being increased to reflect the same amount.

#### **Expenditures**

- Add Data Processing Equipment line \$14,820 to County Commission Budget to purchase laptops/iPads to be used to implement electronic voting using the new CivicPlus program. Maintenance Agreements line is being reduced by the same amount, budget included payment of an annual maintenance agreement for the Civic Plus Program; however, the maintenance agreement is not required for the first year of service.
- Add overtime pay line \$300 to the County Buildings budget to pay an employee, who
  has reached the maximum threshold for comp time hours, overtime for all hours worked
  over 40 to maintain compliance with the Compensatory Time/Overtime Policy amended
  by resolution number 2025063006 on 6/30/25. Decreasing the Part-Time Personnel line
  to cover additional expenses.
- Add comp time payout line \$11,251 and increase social security and employer medicare lines - \$864 - in the County Buildings budget, and decrease fund balance by \$12,115 for the following:
  - Employee promoted to a higher-paying position with the passing of the FY 2025-2026 budget. Payout will be for the entire comp time balance of 210.37 hours at their previous rate of pay. Total cost - \$3,519. Adding to maintain compliance with the Compensatory Time/Overtime Policy amended by resolution number 2025063006 on 6/30/25.
  - One employee (as described in the bullet point above) has reached the maximum threshold for comp time hours. Per the Compensatory Time/Overtime Policy that was amended by Resolution Number 2025063006 on 6/30/25, the budget office reserves the right to pay, at any time, to pay an employee for any and all accrued

- compensatory time. Requesting to pay the employee for 120 hours (1/2 of their current balance) to avoid paying overtime each pay period. Total cost \$4,483.
- O Another employee has almost reached the 240-hour maximum for comp time hours. To maintain compliance with the policy referenced in the paragraphs above, we are requesting to pay the employee for 120 hours (1/2 of their current balance) once the threshold is reached to avoid paying overtime pay each pay period for this employee. Total cost - \$4,113.
- Add Building Improvements Line \$45,000 to County Buildings budget to replace walkin cooler/freezer at God's Storehouse. Project approved by Facilities and Budget Committees. Per resolution number 2025072211, the amount of the project not to exceed \$45,000.
- Add comp time payout line \$291- and increase social security and employer medicare lines \$24 in the Data Processing Services budget to cover payout to an employee who received a promotion to a higher-paying position with the passing of the FY 2025-2026 budget. Payout will be for the entire comp time balance of 11.17 hours at the previous rate of pay. Total cost \$315. Adding to maintain compliance with the Compensatory Time/Overtime Policy amended by resolution number 2025063006 on 6/30/25. Decreasing the Consultants line to cover additional expenses.
- Add Life Insurance, Dental Insurance, and Disability Insurance lines to the Juvenile Court Budget - \$595 to cover insurance premiums for an employee who opted out of countyfunded health insurance. Decreasing the Medical Insurance line to cover.
- Removing various lines from the Other Administration of Justice budget to reflect the ending of Drug Endangered Children (DEC) grant funding as explained under the revenue section above. Total reduction of \$42,010.
- Adding Motor Vehicles line to the Sheriff's Department budget \$406,000. The
  commission approved a budget amendment for the sheriff's department to purchase 7
  patrol vehicles on 3/25/25 using excess interest income revenue; however, the vehicles
  could not be purchased in FY 2024-2025, and the expense needs to be added to the FY
  2025-2026 budget. The unused interest income allocated to this purchase will roll to
  increase fund balance during the year-end process; therefore, fund balance is being
  reduced by the same amount to cover the cost of these vehicles.
- Adjusting various lines within the Jail-EBP Grant Budget to reflect an amendment to the grant budget as explained in the revenue section above. Total Decrease - \$17,637.
- Add In-Service Training, Travel, and Drug & Medical Supplies lines \$46,330 to the Ambulance Service budget to reflect unused funds from the SAMHSA grant received in FY 2024-2025. Funds must be used by 9/30/25. The Other Direct Federal Revenue line also increased under the revenue section above for the same amount.
- Reallocation and addition of various lines of the Rabies and Animal Control budget to better fit the needs of the Animal Shelter. Removing one full-time position and replacing with two part-time positions, as well as adding lines to purchase inmate meals and employee uniforms. Reallocating funds already approved, no change to overall budget amount.

- Add an overtime payout line \$1,798 to the Appropriation to State (DGA Grant) budget to reflect the payout of vacation time balance made to an employee who left the department. Decreasing the Other Salaries and Wages line to cover.
- Increasing lines within the Food Insecurity Grant budget \$57,341 to reflect unspent funds in FY 2024-2025. The Community Development Grants line is also being increased under the revenue section for the same amount.

#### **Equity (Fund Balance)**

- Decreasing Fund Balance by \$463,115 for the following:
  - \$406,000 Addition of Motor Vehicles line to the Sheriff's Department budget as explained under the Expenditure section above
  - \$12,115 Addition of comp time payout line and increase to social security and employer medicare lines in the County Buildings budget in order to pay down comp time balances as explained under the Expenditure section above.
  - \$45,000 Addition of Building Improvement line to County Buildings budget to replace walk-in cooler/freezer at God's Storehouse as explained under the Expenditure section above.

#### Revenues

 Adding Solid Waste Grants line - \$109,997 - to reflect unused funds in the FY25 Recycling Equipment Grant received in FY 2024-2025.

#### **Expenditures**

- Adding Solid Waste Equipment line \$123,552 to the Solid Waste budget to cover grant expenses for the FY25 Recycling Equipment grant referenced above. The grant requires a one-time match, which will be deducted from the fund balance.

(f) (1) The general sessions courts shall not place a defendant who is convicted of a misdemeanor on probation under the supervision of the state department of correction. Nothing in this subsection (f) is intended to restrict the use, where necessary, of any **county or public probation service** or private probation company established for the purpose of supervising defendants convicted of misdemeanors, unless the offender is currently being supervised by the state department of correction on a felony offense.

Furthermore, *Tennessee Code Annotated* §55-10-412(c) in regards to alcohol and drug related driving offenses provides,

(c) The respective counties shall be authorized to expend the funds collected pursuant to subsection (b) by appropriations to any of the following:

. . . . .

(7) The employment of a probation officer for the purposes of supervising drug and alcohol offenders.

**Whereas,** a business plan has been developed as set forth in attached Exhibit A and funds for such office have been provided for in the 2025 - 2026 Lawrence County Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners meeting in regular session this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2025 herby approves and establishes the Department of Probation Services for Lawrence County, adopts the business plan attached hereto as Exhibit A and directs the County Executive with the help of the General Sessions Court Judge, the Circuit Court Clerk and the Office of Accounts and Budgets to establish policies and procedures for the operation of said office.

#### **Executive Summary**

The Lawrence County Office of Probation Services aims to enhance public safety and reduce recidivism by providing effective supervision and support to individuals on probation. Operating under the jurisdiction of the Lawrence County Circuit Court, the office will be staffed by a Director, a Probation Officer, and a part-time Administrative Assistant. The office will be located in the Lawrence County Courthouse, with office space provided by the county at no cost. All financial transactions will be managed by the Lawrence County Circuit Court Clerk's Office.

#### **Organizational Structure**

- Director: Responsible for overall management, policy implementation, and coordination with the court system.
- Probation Officer: Handles case management, supervises probationers, and ensures compliance with court orders.
- Part-Time Administrative Assistant: Provides clerical support, manages records, and assists with scheduling.

#### **Operations Plan**

Location: Lawrence County Courthouse, Lawrenceburg, TN.

Office Hours: Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM.

#### Services Provided:

- - Supervision of court-ordered probationers.
- - Coordination with treatment programs and community resources.
- - Monitoring compliance with probation terms.
- Reporting to the Circuit Court on probationer progress.

#### **Financial Plan**

All financial transactions, including the collection of supervision fees, will be handled by the Lawrence County Circuit Court Clerk's Office. These funds will support the operational costs of the Probation Services Office.

WHEREAS, the owners have further requested that if such expansion of the library is not commenced within fifteen (15) years from the date the land is conveyed to Lawrence County, the owners shall have the right to repurchase the land from Lawrence County for the sum of \$80,000.00; and,

- 2. To be eligible for the incentive payment, the continuing education credits required for one incentive payment must be different from those used in obtaining or recertifying for other certifications that qualify for the incentive bonuses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners meeting in regular session on this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2025, that:

SECTION 1. **NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED** by the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners meeting in regular session this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2025 that there is hereby appropriated a sum not to exceed \$45,000.00 for the purchase and installation of a new walk-in cooler/freezer at the property located at 425 Frank Streeet, Lawrenceburg, Tennessee, such funds to be paid from the General Fund (Fund 101).

# RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 2023092607 REGARDING INCENTIVE PAYMENTS FOR LAWRENCE COUNTY EMPLOYEES WHO COMPLETE THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE (CAPC) THROUGH THE COUNTY TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE SERVICE (CTAS)

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2023092607 the Lawrence County Board of Commissioners provided an incentive payment in the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for those Lawrence County employees who enroll in, complete and receive the County Administrative Professional Certificate (CAPC), a program which consists of a variety of topics related to technology, communication, and interpersonal skills and is geared toward those who directly deal with customers and those whose primary job functions are administrative in nature.

WHEREAS, Lawrence County Board of Commissioners desires to amend Resolution No. 2023092607 to provide an incentive five hundred dollars (\$500) for completion of the CAPC course and an incentive in the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) per annum to those Lawrence County employees who complete an additional (8) hours of continuing education during the course of a fiscal year (July-June) and submit to the County Executive proof of such completion.

WHEREAS, Lawrence County Board of Commissioners desires to further amend Resolution No. 2023092607 to add the following language,

SECTION 2. All online certifications and CAPC credits cannot be earned while the employee is at work but rather must be earned while the employee is not on duty; and

SECTION 3. To be eligible for the incentive payment, the continuing education credits required for one incentive payment must be different from those used in obtaining or recertifying for other certifications that qualify for the incentive bonuses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners meeting in regular session on this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2025, that Resolution No. 2023092607 is amended to state:

SECTION 1. Any full-time paid employee who has completed the CAPC and attained the County Administrative Professional Certificate and who submits to the County Executive proof of such attainment, shall be paid the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) for completion of the CAPAC course and an incentive in the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) per annum to those Lawrence County employees who complete an additional (8) hours of continuing education during the course of a fiscal year (July-June) and submit to the County Executive proof of such completion, such amount to be net of any taxes, whereby the employee takes home five hundred dollars (\$500). This incentive will be included in the budget and paid annually upon completion of continuing education hours.

SECTION 2. All online certifications and CAPC credits cannot be earned while the employee is at work but rather must be earned while the employee is not on duty; and

SECTION 3. To be eligible for the incentive payment, the continuing education credits required for one incentive payment must be different from those used in obtaining or recertifying for other certifications that qualify for the incentive bonuses.

This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.

## TO PROVIDE FOR EDUCATION INCENTIVE PAYMENTS TO COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY MEMBERS OF LAWRENCE COUNTY GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, under T.C.A. § 5-5-113, counties are authorized and encouraged to pay a supplement of six hundred dollars (\$600) to county legislative body members who successfully complete in each year at least eight (8) hours of continuing education training at conferences or meetings provided or approved by the County Technical Assistance Service (CTAS); and

WHEREAS, Lawrence County desires to provide for such an incentive payment in the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600) to county legislative body members who successfully complete the annual training, subject to budget availability and appropriation of funds.

WHEREAS, Lawrence County desires to provide said incentive payment in the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600) per annum to those county legislative body members who successfully complete the eight (8) hours of annual training during the course of a fiscal year (July-June) and submit proof of such completion to the Office of Accounts and Budgets, subject to the qualification that the continuing education credits required must be different from those used in obtaining or recertifying for other certifications that qualify for the incentive bonuses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners, meeting in regular session on this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2025, that:

SECTION 1. Any county legislative body member of Lawrence County who is eligible to receive the incentive payment under Tennessee Code Annotated § 5-5-13, who has completed at least eight (8) hours of continuing education training at conferences or meetings provided or approved by CTAS and whose completion of such training has been verified by CTAS and has been submitted proof of such verification to the Office of Accounts and Budgets shall be paid the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600), such amount to be net of any taxes, whereby the county legislative body member takes how six hundred dollars (\$600). This incentive will be included in the budget and paid annually upon completion of the eight (8) hours of annual training; subject to the qualification that the continuing education credits required must be different from those used in obtaining or recertifying for other certifications that qualify for the incentive bonuses
