AGENDA MEETING

Date: May, 6th, 2025 | **Time:** 5:03-5:16 p.m.

PRESENT: Commissioners: Phillip Heatherly, Chris Sutherland, Delano Benefield, Travis Cauwels, Shane Eaton, and Steve Hagan. **County Attorney** Charlie Holt.

Commissioner Eaton called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Heatherly listed several items he had for the agenda:

The McKinstry contract, right-of-Way contract, updated road specs, naming the bridge on Busby Road, and the Columbia State Lease agreement.

Holt gave update on the Economic Corporation Board. There are 5 acres near Craig Manufacturing and Magna that have been designated for drainage easement; there is more than enough land for it. Thomas Caterpillar, from Nashville, wants to set up a service center here and purchase a portion of the land. The Board will be asking to sell part of the land between \$50,000 and \$84,000. Also, any Budget amendments we have can be added onto the agenda.

Commissioner Eaton noted the Animal Welfare Committee will be meeting May 13 to discuss the Sheriff's Department taking over management of the Animal Shelter. Will have to approve an interlocal agreement with the city.

The meeting concluded at 5:16 p.m.
