Code Ann. § 40-14-210*, this county commission has previously approved and implemented a twelve dollar and fifty cent (\$12.50) cost to be added to the cost bill and be collected in all criminal proceedings for the benefit and use of the district public defender's office, and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee General Assembly has recently enacted similar legislation for the benefit of the District Attorney General, and

WHEREAS, upon adoption of an appropriate resolution by a county legislative body, *Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-3-106* makes it the duty of the Circuit Court Clerk of every court in that county having jurisdiction of state misdemeanors and felonies to include in every misdemeanor and felony cost bill, a charge of twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) that must be remitted to the office of the executive director of the district attorneys general conference for the purpose of providing supplemental funding for the office of the district attorney general within the 22nd Judicial District. This charge shall not apply to nonmoving traffic violations. Any unencumbered moneys and any unexpended balance of such funds remaining at the end of a fiscal year do not revert to the state general fund but must be carried forward for the purpose for which they were originally intended; and

WHEREAS, under *Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-3-106* the aforesaid clerks may only charge the twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) upon adoption of a resolution by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the county legislative body of such county; and

WHEREAS, the county legislative body in LAWRENCE County, Tennessee finds that implementation and collection of the foregoing charge is in the best interests of the county.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lawrence County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session at Lawrenceburg, Tennessee, on this 23rd day of September, 2025, that:

SECTION 1. The Circuit Court Clerk of Lawrence County having jurisdiction of state misdemeanors and felonies shall include in every misdemeanor and felony cost bill, a charge of twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) that must be remitted to the office of the executive director of the district attorneys general conference for the purpose of providing supplemental funding for the office of the district attorney general in the 22nd Judicial District. Any unencumbered moneys and any unexpended balance of such funds remaining at the end of a fiscal year do not revert to

the state general fund but must be carried forward for the purpose for which they were originally intended;

SECTION 2. All costs collected by LAWRENCE County government pursuant to this Resolution must be used for providing support services for the purpose of promoting public safety at the sole discretion of the district attorney general for the 22nd Judicial District;

SECTION 3. LAWRENCE County may supplement the funds of the district attorney general system to promote public safety. The costs collected by Lawrence County under this Resolution are supplemental and in addition to any funds received under *Tenn. Code Ann.* § 40-3-106 or under title 8, chapter 7 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, relative to district attorneys general;

SECTION 4. In every misdemeanor and felony prosecution in which restitution is ordered or the privilege tax for the criminal injuries compensation fund established by *Tenn. Code Ann.* § 40-24-107 is also levied, the cost imposed by this Resolution does not have priority over collection of that restitution or privilege tax; and

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, the public welfare requiring it.

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2011012509A the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners approved the Economic Impact Plan as previously approved by The Economic Development Corporation of Lawrence County (the “County Board”); and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of said Resolution provided,

Section 3: Until the County Commission and the County Board approve a project within the District, and debt is issued, a portion of the incremental increase in property taxes within the District over and above Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars shall revert to the County general fund.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2018072410 the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners amended Section 3 of Resolution No. 2011012509A to provide as follows,

Section 3: Until the County Commission and the County Board approve a project within the district, and debt is issued, the portion of the incremental increase in property taxes within the District over and above One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars shall revert to the County general fund.

WHEREAS, it appears that Lawrence County has failed to transfer to the County Board the portion of the incremental increases in property taxes in the District created by the Economic Impact Plan as adopted by the County Board since 2019 however, instead of making a transfer to the County Board is TIF funds, state auditors have advised that the appropriate method is to make a charitable contribution to the County Board in lieu of TIF funds; and

WHEREAS, the County Board has requested the sum of \$161,000 be contributed to the County Board to enable the County Board to purchase a parcel of property located at the corner of Hagan Road and U. S. Hwy. 43 North, which parcel of property is contiguous to a 151 acre parcel of property already owned by the County Board and which property is vital to the development of the 151 acre tract and the purchase price for said property is being funded by a grant from the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development, except for the sum of \$161,000.

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the citizens and residents of Lawrence County to make such transfer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners meeting in regular session this 23rd day of September, 2025 approves a charitable contribution in the sum of \$161,000.00, in lieu of the incremental increases in property taxes in the District created by the Economic Impact Plan since such funds were last transferred to the County Board, such charitable contribution to come from the General Fund (Fund 101) and the 2025-2026 Budget is so amended.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LAWRENCE COUNTY AMBULANCE SERVICE TO PROVIDE DEDICATED AMBULANCE STANDBY FOR EVENTS AND TO CHARGE A FEE NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00) PER HOUR; AND TO ESTABLISH POLICIES AND PROCEDURES INCLUDING DISCRETIONARY REDUCTIONS OR WAIVERS FOR QUALIFYING NONPROFIT APPLICANTS

WHEREAS, Lawrence County Ambulance Service (“LCAS”) provides countywide emergency medical response and transport; and

WHEREAS, from time to time event organizers and sponsors request a dedicated ambulance and crew to be staged exclusively at a private or public event (“Dedicated Standby”) separate from routine emergency response coverage; and

WHEREAS, providing Dedicated Standby services imposes personnel, apparatus, and operational costs and must be managed to preserve countywide 9-1-1 readiness; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee law authorizes counties to operate emergency medical services and to charge fees or rates for such services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in Regular Session on this 23rd day of September 2025, that:

SECTION 1. Authorization; Fee Ceiling. LCAS is authorized to provide Dedicated Standby ambulance coverage for events upon request and availability. LCAS may charge the event organizer or sponsor a fee not to exceed \$150.00 per hour per ambulance for Dedicated Standby services.

SECTION 2. Policies and Procedures; Discretionary Waivers. LCAS is authorized to promulgate written policies and procedures governing request intake, scheduling, staffing level, minimum time blocks, billing and collections, and operational protocols for Dedicated Standby. Those policies may include discretionary reduced rates or waivers for bona fide § 501(c)(3) or comparable charitable nonprofit events upon written application demonstrating public benefit or hardship. Eligibility criteria and any caps on the number or value of waivers per fiscal year shall be defined by LCAS policy.

SECTION 3. Minimums; Timekeeping; Deposits. LCAS policies may:
(a) require a minimum billable block (e.g., two or three hours) and allow billing in whole or partial hours thereafter;

- (b) commence billable time upon unit arrival at the designated staging location and conclude upon release; and
- (c) require a reasonable advance deposit and establish cancellation deadlines and fees.

SECTION 4. Scope of Coverage; Emergency Departure. Dedicated Standby units are primarily assigned to the event. If, in LCAS's judgment, a higher-priority emergency occurs and no alternate unit is immediately available, LCAS shall depart the event to fulfill its emergency obligations. LCAS will use best efforts to backfill coverage at the event if practicable.

SECTION 5. Priority; Availability. All Dedicated Standby requests are subordinate to 9-1-1 operational needs and subject to staffing and unit availability. LCAS may decline, reschedule, or modify a request to maintain countywide service levels.

SECTION 6. Staffing Levels; Service Types. LCAS policies may differentiate service levels (e.g., BLS or ALS ambulance), supplemental resources (e.g., bike/UTV teams, supervisor), and corresponding rates, provided no rate exceeds the ceiling set in Section 1 unless later amended by this Body.

SECTION 7. Insurance; Indemnity; Site Safety. LCAS may require organizers to: (a) maintain reasonable event liability insurance naming Lawrence County as additional insured; (b) execute an agreement with indemnification and hold-harmless provisions customary for such services; and (c) meet site safety requirements (clear access routes, staging areas, and communications contacts).

SECTION 8. Billing; Collections; Nonpayment. LCAS shall invoice organizers per policy (e.g., within 30 days of service). Policies may address late fees, cost recovery for extraordinary consumables, and procedures for habitual nonpayment, all consistent with county financial controls.

SECTION 9. Compliance with Law and Licensure. All Dedicated Standby operations shall comply with applicable Tennessee statutes and regulations governing EMS licensure, staffing, and operations

SECTION 10. Administrative Implementation. The County Executive and LCAS Director are authorized to take all actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including adopting and publishing the policies described herein.

This resolution shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.

MEMORIAL CHAPEL TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY HOUSING OF
CADAVERS IN THE EVENT OF MULTIPLE FATALITIES OR LIMITED
HOSPITAL CAPACITY, AND TO AUTHORIZE PAYMENT OF A DAILY RATE
OF FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS FOR SUCH SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Lawrence County is responsible for ensuring the dignified and secure handling of deceased persons in cases of accidental fatalities, natural disasters, or other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the local hospital may from time to time be unable to accommodate cadavers due to limited storage capacity; and

WHEREAS, Loretto Memorial Chapel maintains suitable facilities to temporarily house cadavers in a safe and respectful manner consistent with professional and public health standards; and

WHEREAS, the availability of such facilities under a standing agreement will promote public safety, dignity, and preparedness for extraordinary circumstances; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lawrence County Legislative Body meeting in Regular Session on this 23rd day of September, 2025, that:

SECTION 1. Authorization of Agreement. Lawrence County is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Loretto Memorial Chapel to provide temporary housing of cadavers when the local hospital is unable to do so, whether as a result of multiple fatalities, natural disasters, or other emergencies creating extraordinary need.

SECTION 2. Rate of Compensation. The County shall compensate Loretto Memorial Chapel at a daily rate not to exceed Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per day, per cadaver, as invoiced pursuant to the agreement.

SECTION 3. Policies and Procedures. The County Executive, in consultation with the County Medical Examiner and Emergency Management, shall establish policies and procedures governing when the arrangement may be invoked, the manner of transfer, documentation required, and any conditions for release.

SECTION 4. Term and Availability. This agreement shall be ongoing unless

terminated by either party in writing, provided that the Chapel remains licensed and available to provide such services in accordance with Tennessee law.

SECTION 5. Funding. Payment for services rendered under this Resolution shall be made from the General Fund or such other fund as the Budget Committee may recommend and the County Commission may approve.

SECTION 6. Implementation. The County Executive is authorized to negotiate, execute, and administer all documents necessary to implement this Resolution consistent with its terms.

SECTION 7. Budget Amended. The 2025-2026 Budget is so amended.

This resolution shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
