RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE SPEED LIMIT ON CEMETERY ROAD TO 30 MILES PER HOUR FOR THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF SAID ROAD

WHEREAS, Cemetery Road is a county road in Lawrence County that runs in a general east to west direction and runs from the State Tote 240 (Central Turnpike) on its east end to Chief Creek Road on its western end and is approximately 2.3 miles in length; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the residents on Cemetery Road have signed a petition to set a speed limit of 35 miles per hour for the safety of vehicles being operated and pedestrians walking on Cemetery Road; and,

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners deems that the public safety requires that the speed limit on Cemetery Road be changed to 30 miles per hour the entire length of said road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lawrence County Board of County Commissioners meeting in regular session this the 23rd day of September, 2025, that the speed limit on Cemetery Road be changed to 30 miles per hour the entire length of said road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Road Superintendent for Lawrence County is hereby requested to erect appropriate signs to reflect that the speed limit is 30 miles per hour on the entire length of Cemetery Road.

This resolution shall take effect upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
