AGENDA MEETING

Date: Tuesday, March 3, 2026 | **Time:** 5:00-5:15 p.m.

PRESENT: County Executive David Morgan. **Commissioners** Chris Sutherland, Shane Eaton, Dave Ray, Phillip Heatherly, Steve Hagan, Sandy Newton, and Barry Luffman, **County Attorney** Ryan Durham, **Chief Deputy** George Barturen, and several county residents.

Eaton: called the meeting to order

- **Durham:** stated items he is aware of for the March 24 Commission agenda:
 - Budget amendments, minute approval, notary elections, other standard reports.
 - Honorariums to South Lawrence Girls Middle School Class A State Champions and 35-year employee in Brady Hutton's office
 - Contract between state and county for state-supported child support service officer. State has produced an amendment, requires county approval. No additional money is required from our side.
- **Commissioner Eaton: Commissioner Franks** to amend resolution for water line additions approved in February meeting, additional \$3,000.
- **Commissioner Heatherly:** Following Budget Committee approval of items out of Emergency Services Committee, will add rate increase and new ambulance purchase for EMS.
- **Commissioner Ray:** Honorarium for 4-H student; potentially letter of support for SB 2311, regarding county approval of any city annexation.
- **Commissioner Newton:** Question about honoring employee – others have not been.
- **Commissioner Eaton:** Replied that we need to start at some point
- **Commissioner Ray:** Need to establish a rolling list of employees' anniversaries so they can be honored.
- **Commissioner Heatherly:** Asked about status of Inter-local solid waste agreement with the city on solid waste.
- **Executive Morgan:** A couple of issues remain to be hashed out with Lawrenceburg City Manager Dick McKinley, then it will be passed on to City and County Attorneys.

- **Commissioner Luffman:** Asked about status of sale of STHC to Columbia State. **State Sen. Page Walley** told **Executive Morgan** it has been submitted to a legislative committee, once approved, city/county and CSCC might make changes, which would require another state approval. CSCC offer stands at \$9 million
